

Dear Parents/Carers.

In 2019, the Government introduced a Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) for children to complete at the end of Year 4. Due to Covid-19, this was postponed until this academic year when it is now a compulsory requirement. It will take place for our current Year 4 pupils in June 2022 and the following summer for our current Year 3 pupils.

During the assessment, children will use a laptop or ipad to answer multiplication questions, with just 6 seconds to type in the answer. The questions will be based on all of the times tables up to 12x12, assessing pupil's fluency in recalling these facts mentally.

While Summer 2023 may feel some time away, to support children achieve to the very best of their ability it is essential we all start working towards this assessment now.
